

100 Days of Mark Making

Goals:

- Experiment with surface design product and techniques to make my own marks/designs/texture/patterns.

My Process:

- Roll Dice to determine mark making product and design to create one or more fabric swatches measuring 10" square or bigger using Black PFD, White PFD, and/or Hand Dyed Fabrics.
- Create a minimum of 4 finished projects featuring fabrics created in project
- Color Assignments by Days 1-14 Black & White; 15-28 Red; 29-42 Orange; 43-56 Yellow; 57-70 Green; 71-84 Blue; 85-98 Purple; 99-100 Multicolor (Black & White accents permitted)

Documentation:

- Post daily on Instagram. Include photos of dice roll, products/tools used, and finished (or batching) fabric.
- Weekly Blog Post with reflections/insights, and potentially videos
- Blog post for 4 finished quilts featuring fabrics made during 100 Day Projects
